The Comptroller's office has accepted your offer to settle your Maryland income tax liability for tax year(s) under the Offer in Compromise Program.

After receipt and posting of all required payments to your account, the Comptroller's office will abate the remaining balance due and release any notices of tax lien for the tax years shown above. The Comptroller's office will mail releases of notices of tax lien to you. If you default upon the payment plan, the full liability will become due immediately and this office will take action to collect the balance due.

Please note that the conditions of the offer require you to timely file and pay all required taxes for three tax years after the Offer in Compromise application is accepted. If you do not, the full liability will become due immediately and this office will take action to collect the debt.

Offer in Compromise Payment Instructions

1. To pay via credit card, go to <https://www.velocitypayment.com/client/rad/> (There is a 2.45% service/convenience fee, with a \$1.00 minimum). Select Existing Liability w/Notice Number and Tax Type Personal Income Tax. Your notice number is provided on your acceptance letter.



2. To pay via check online, go to <https://interactive.marylandtaxes.gov/Individuals/IndivLogin/default.asp>. You must register for an account. After logging on to the Comptroller's Individual's Online Service Center you will be asked to provide the account type (checking or savings), bank routing number and account number.
